
SUNY Ulster brings the inaugural show by the International Society of Antiquaries, titled "Collective Expeditions," to the Muroff Kotler Visual Arts Gallery from November 8 to December 13. An opening reception will be held on Friday, November 8, from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m. in the Muroff Kotler Visual Arts Gallery in Vanderlyn Hall, room 265. This event is free and open to the public.

The International Society of Antiquaries is a league of artists who are bound by a desire to look back in order to look forward. "Collective Expeditions" features painting, works on paper, sculpture, and installation. Although the artists have diverse practices, their work fits together in complex and interesting ways that speak to the importance of understanding our past—sometimes as far back as prehistory—in order to comprehend who we are as a species and where we are going. The works reference tribal, shamanic, ancestral, and contemporary art. 
